

REPORT

In January 2010, professor Nikolaos Karanasios, proposed us to host 35 persons in Labor Market, as apprenticeships.

He is known to us from the time he was invited by the University of Calabria as an exchange lecturer and also as a partner of the “Centro d’ Ingegneria Economica e Sociale (CIES)” as prof. Jacques Guenot was managing it and it was developing international relations.

We also participated, under the guidance of prof. Karanasios at the Serres Development Conference in 2003 and also, as invited scientist entrepreneurs, at two Leonardo Projects, in 2003 and 2004, organized by the Serres Business and Innovation Centre (BIC), where he is CEO, in addition to being an assistant professor of the TEI of Serres.

Our company responded and sent the appropriate document to be submitted b the Chamber of Commerce Development Company (EPANESER) where prof. Karanasios is a member of the Directory Board (Secretary General) and he was preparing a Leonardo da Vinci proposal.

The proposal was not initially successful and was listed as reserve.



In February 2011, we have been notified that the proposal was approved for 15 participants, changing all budgetary aspects. Later in February 2011, prof. Karanasios visited our headquarters and reshaped with us, on one hand he apprenticeship program, adapting it to the evolution in Territorial Marketing occurred and budgetary accounts.

Based on past experience and after a research for better accommodation conditions, within the financial limits of the approved budget, the Hotel Marechiaro, has been proposed to the sending organization, as of better service than any other alternative, so we advised the sending organization to choose it for full accommodation.

As foreseen, we provided two engineers as supervisor/instructors, Nikola Silva and Stefano de Giacomo.

Combining our experience of preparing the users of our software and that of the coordinator (prof. Karanasios) we came out with an apprenticeship program in a sequence starting from the structure of both the system and the software, passing through the group work of adapting the menu translation, sorting out the commercialization aspects and ending with the event submission to the portal “Italia sulla rete”.

No problems occurred, requiring one intervention, we only learned that one of the participants had an allergic reaction to an insect bite and the hotel people handled it successfully and with a total satisfaction.

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
